# EMERGENCY PLAN: HOSTILE INTRUDER

A step-by-step guide on what to do in the event of a hostile intruder.

### **RUN**

Be alert and determine if you can escape safely. If possible, the best course of action is to GET OUT.



### HIDE

If escape is not possible:

- HIDE OUT: Locate a room with locks, barricade the door, and stay quiet.
- TAKE COVER: Hide behind items that would deflect a bullet if necessary.



# **FIGHT**

MAKE A PLAN, and work with others to stay safe. While hiding, be active and prepare to fight an intruder if necessary. Locate items that could be used to protect yourselves.



## **CONTACT POLICE**

When possible, call 911. Inform the responder of your location and what danger you are in. When help arrives, REMAIN CALM, and follow instructions from the police.
